Junior Research Technology Seminar and Graduation Exhibition

In their Junior Year, all students must:

- 1. Successfully complete the Junior Research Technology Seminar semester course and,
- 2. Meet or exceed the standard on their Graduation Exhibition.

The *Junior Research Technology Seminar* will require students to research a topic of personal interest and produce an argumentative research paper. Other supporting assignments, such as a journal, abstract and a portfolio are additional elements necessary for successful completion of the course. By the end of the course students will determine the initial plan for their final exhibition. During this exhibition, students will present their findings and additional information via a form of technology to a panel of judges comprised of teachers, administrators and members of the community.
