



- Children and youths who are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, or similar settings
- Migratory children or children removed from the home

Unaccompanied Youth are young people experiencing homelessness who are not in the physical custody of a parent or guardian.

The FACE Office can help with:

- Questions and concerns about the district or school programs and activities.
- Enrolling in school with flexibility for required documents.
- Transportation services, in district or out of district, for a school bus to and from school, RIPTIKs or RIPTA monthly bus passes, as appropriate and necessary.
- Accessing afterschool or extra curriculum activities.
- Providing basic school supplies and referral for clothing and other potential needs.
- Guidance and connections to helpful resources for youth who are on their own.
- Connecting to local and state resources; food, housing, transportation, and social services.
- Translation services.
