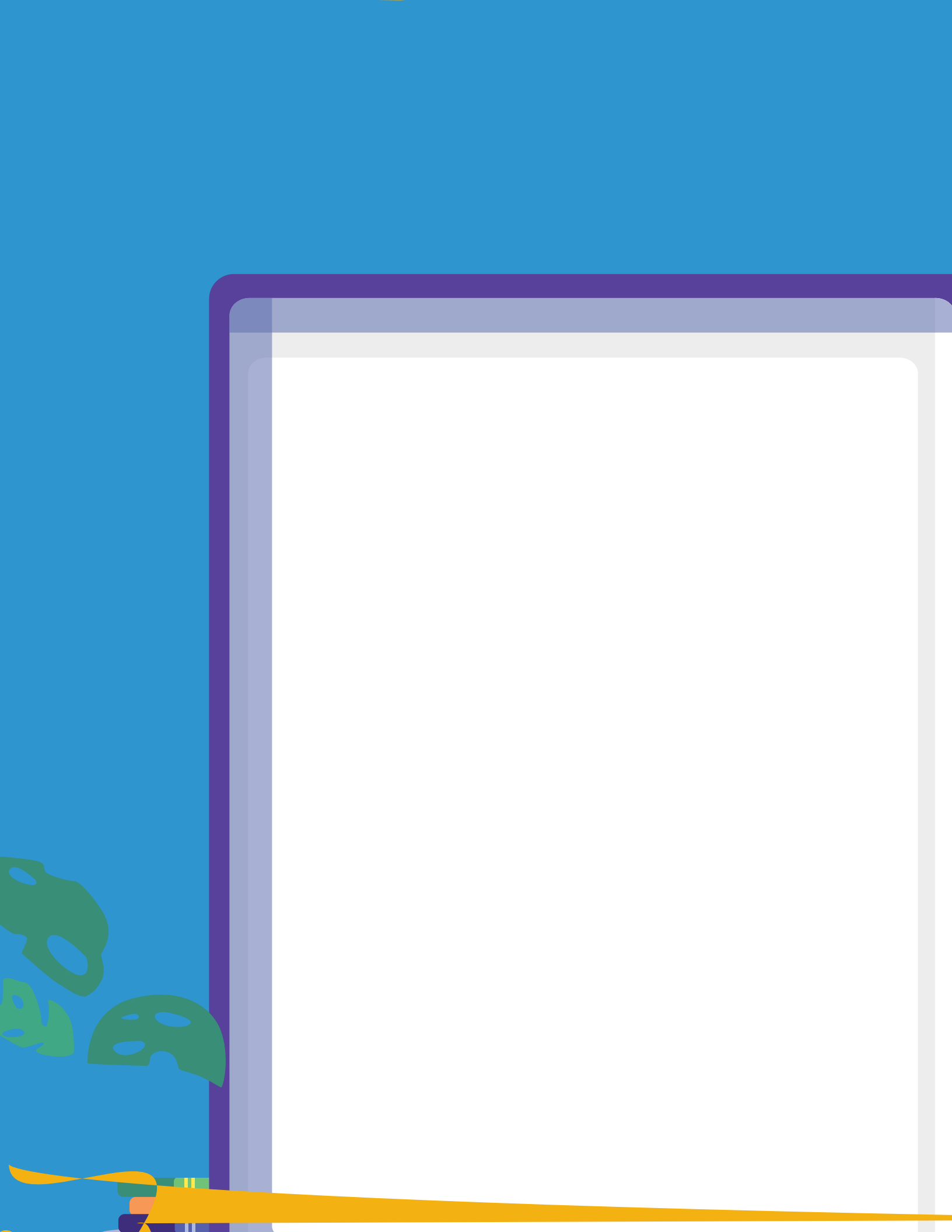

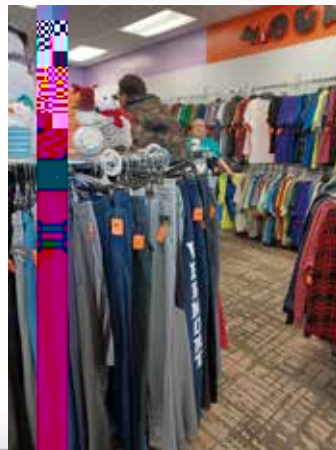
## LIMA NEWS CREW
