DISTRICT PARENT ADVISORY COUNCIL (PAC)

What is the Parent Advisory Council (PAC)?

The PAC is a district wide parent organization. Its purpose is to ensure that parents have an organized voice in the district; that parents are involved in decision-making processes and procedures, as appropriate and permitted by law; and, that parent needs, concerns and issues are communicated, addressed by, and resolved before the School Board and Superintendent regularly and effectively.

Who comprises the PAC?

The PAC shall be primarily comprised of parent members, with one from each school in the district. There shall also be one member from the Special Education Local Advisory Committee and one member selected by the Superintendent from the community-at-large.
